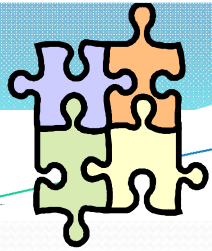
CONCLUSIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS

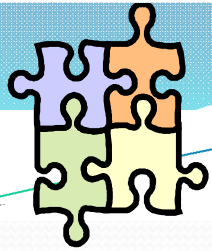
CONCLUSIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. To achieve affective and efficient monitoring
 - Harmonize data
 - Consider sustainability of monitoring
 - staff turn over & compensation
 - appropriate low cost less-data methods
 - Costs & Financing mechanisms
 - Pilot studies
 - Ownership of process
 - Support networks
 - Ensure monitoring tied to objectives of management and monitoring plan
 - Optimize reliability

CONCLUSIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. To achieve affective and efficient monitoring
- 2. Linking monitoring to management
 - Improve the practice of communicating and interpreting results
 - Complete the adaptive management loop -balance effort between 1) collecting and 2) interpreting and using information
 - Adapt and strengthen mechanisms that are flexible enough to respond to the needs of adaptive management
