**2. Updates on your activities (**new initiatives/programs/projects of your government /organization which will be of interest to the ICRI Members)

UNEP-WCMC and partners are initiating a process to develop minimum standards for coral reef baseline data, to support monitoring and assessment at local scales that can be interoperable with global datasets and assessments. Establishing these minimum standards includes defining core attributes – attributes that are fundamental to most users of this dataset and that are deemed essential for every data point measured. To gain an understanding of what these core attributes should be, a necessary first step is to review and standardise the attributes currently stored in the global coral reef data layer that is hosted by UNEP-WCMC, compiled from multiple sources, including the Millennium Coral Mapping Project. The attributes are therefore not currently consistent across the dataset. Expert knowledge is requested to organise the current attributes into a consistent classification, and ICRI members are invited to participate in this process. The timeline is to complete it by Jan 31 2012.
