- Nesting location, species, success
- Stranded
- Illegal Take
- Lay persons Adopt A Beach or Reef and submit observations
- Biologists conduct in-wwater surveys & monitor nesting beaches

- Establish baseline data for sea turtle abundance

- Produce Updated STRAP




