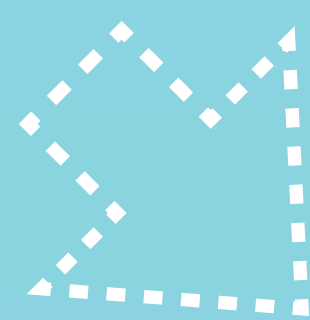

1995 FIRST ICRI INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP (DUMAGUETE, PHILIPPINES)

Adopted the ICRI "Call to Action" and "Framework for Action"

Recommended each region to organize regional workshops and develop its own regional strategy to address regional agendas.

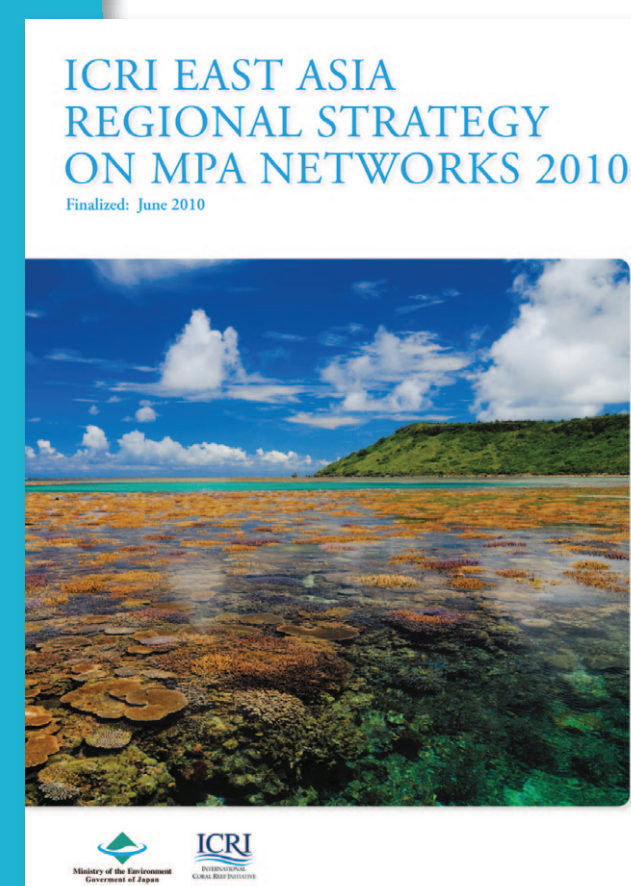
