

“Protected Area Compliance Management – A Structured Approach”

Four-Day Pre-Conference Workshop

Delegate Selection Criteria

The primary purpose of the workshop is to equip delegates with a first draft Compliance Management capacity building plan for their agency. This will be based upon a detailed understanding of special models, tools and techniques needed to plan and deliver environmental outcomes through the management of compliance.

The secondary purpose of the workshop is to establish a representative group of Protected Area managers who will participate in a long term agenda to professionalise Compliance Management based upon a framework of competency standards, training, education and qualifications.

Delegates will ideally

- Be experienced in establishing and/or managing a Protected Area
- Have Compliance Management in their portfolio of responsibilities
- Be of such seniority that they have influence to develop and resource Compliance Management initiatives within their agency and region
- Be willing to maintain a long-term contribution to an expert group that will guide a global approach to the management of compliance in Protected Areas

Selection will be done on the basis of achieving the best possible representation of all regions.

In anticipation of the workshop being oversubscribed, it is proposed that additional workshops will be offered in 2015.

Through the International Centre for Compliance Management, participants will have access to support in establishing a Compliance Management Unit including business processes, document templates, training, and mentoring.
