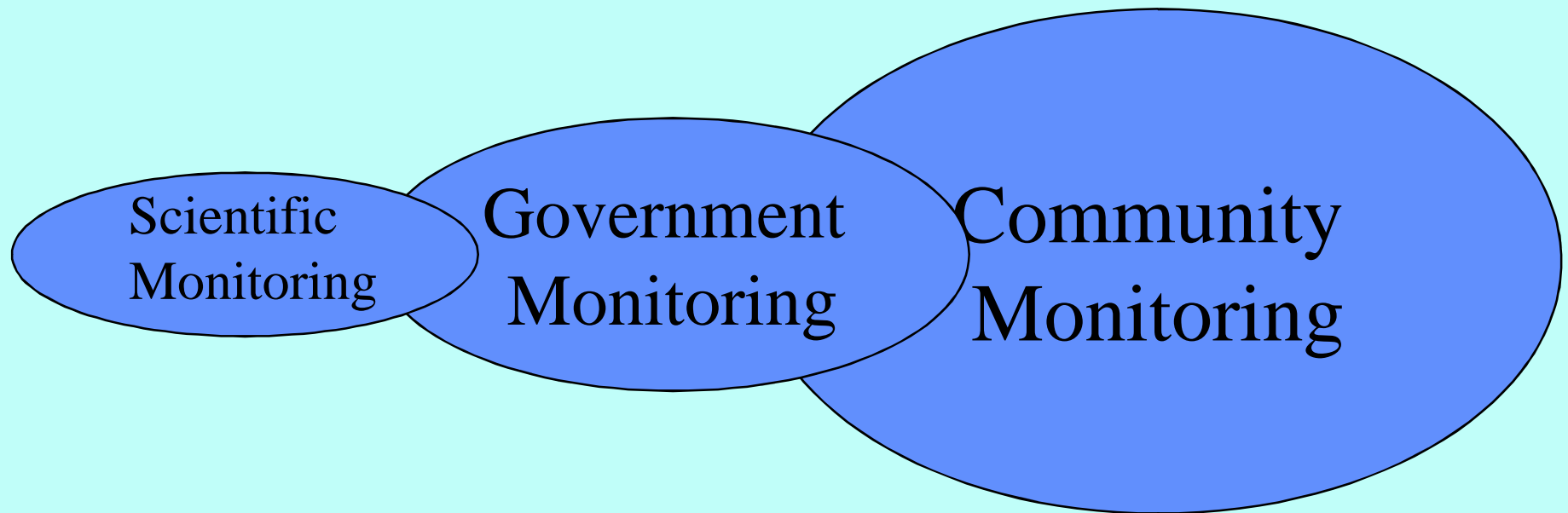

Structure

- 1 global coordinator – Clive Wilkinson
- Several monitoring partners/ components e.g. SocMon (Christy Loper), Reef Check (Gregor Hodgson), CRISP (Eric Clua), CORDIO, AGRRA etc.
- Associated partners – ICRAN, WRI
- Operates through 17 Nodes coordinated by an expert group in the region

Possible Future Structure

- ‘Business as usual’ 1 global coordinator
- 2 Global Coordinators (1 + assistant with a view ...)
- 2 to 4 p/t regional coordinators supported by p/t global coordinator
- Regions –
 - Wider Indian Ocean inc ROPME & PERSGA
 - SE & E Asia
 - Wider Pacific
 - Wider Caribbean
