








Mapping the funding landscape for coral reef restoration efforts

Context

- Increase interest in coral reef restoration globally- particularly now that we've entered the UN Decade on Ecosystem Restoration
- New reports and resolutions = call for increased regional and international commitments for coral reef restoration BUT
- Guiding these commitments require a better understanding of:
 - Types of funding available
 - How that may vary across regions
 - Contrast with what's required/needed









Aims of the Report

- Understand the type of investment made for coral reef restoration from 2015 to 2020 + how funding varied across regions, sectors, and/or type of restoration projects
- Identify specific funding gaps and needs and draw accurate recommendations for future commitments and investments
- If possible, identify links (or lack of) between funding and success indicators

Build up on: 1. **UNEP (2018)'s** Analysis of international funding for the sustainable management of coral reefs and associated coastal ecosystems

2. **UNEP-WCMC, FFI and ELP (2020)'s** Funding Ecosystem Restoration in Europe: A summary of funding trends and recommendations to inform practitioners, policymakers and funders

 - Barriers to effective funding

Timeline

Practitioners and managers as secondary audience

- Project development: January to first week of February
- Online survey: *Live until the end of February*

Governments, international development agencies, funding bodies, etc....

• Report delivery: *End of March*
