UNGA proclaimed 2 February, the date of adoption of the Convention on Wetlands, as World Wetlands Day (A/RES/75/317)

Acknowledges the essential role of wetlands in achieving the SDGs, but also that they are among the ecosystems with the highest rates of decline and loss

Invites all UN member states, organizations and other stakeholders to observe and raise awareness
