- Achieve early actions to **align national biodiversity targets, monitoring frameworks, policy mainstreaming, and biodiversity finance** using **whole-of-government and whole-of-society** approaches
- Create a positive **enabling environment** for nature-focused national biodiversity policy

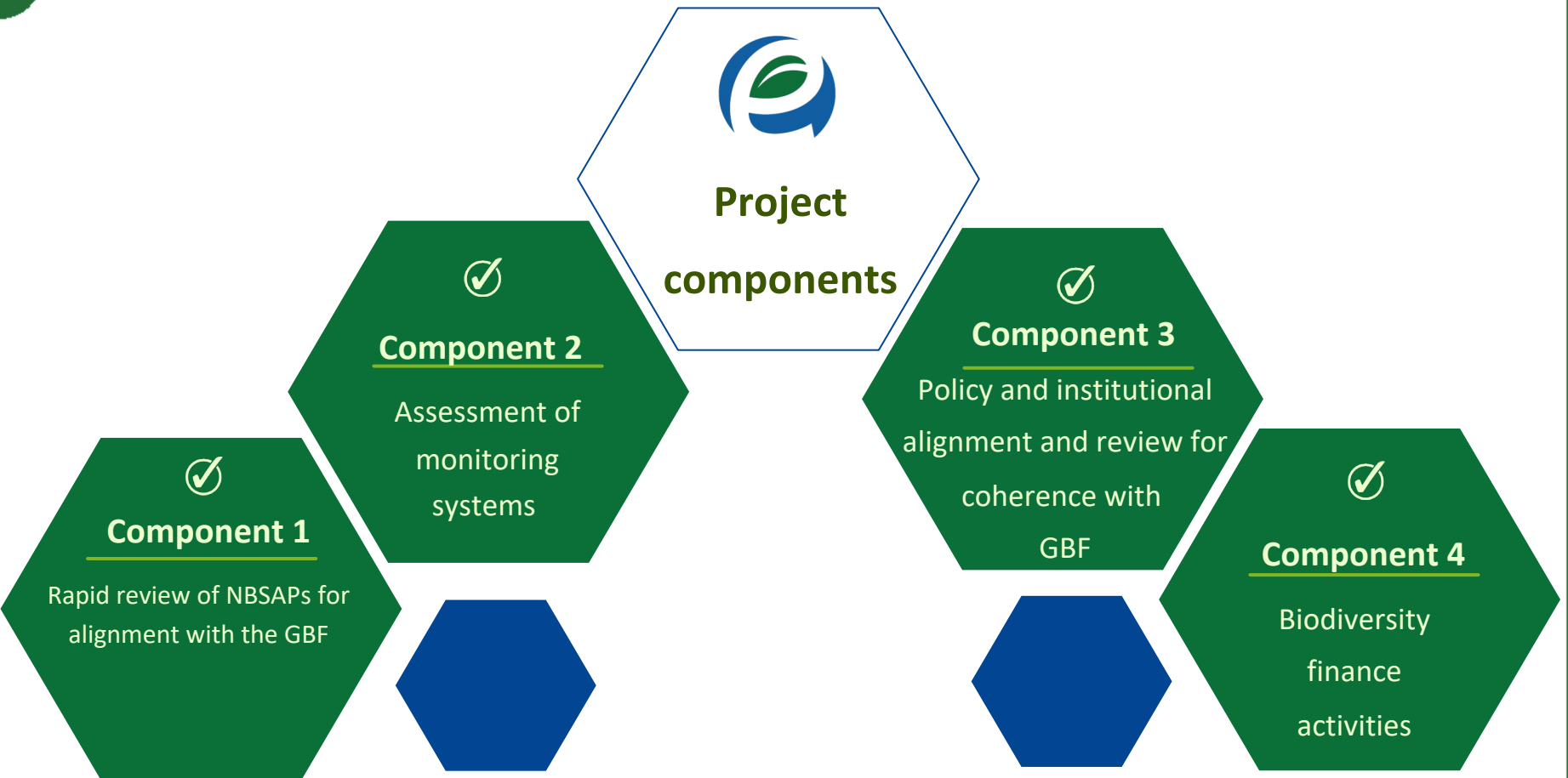


Objective of the Early Action Support Project

To fast-track readiness and early actions to implement the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework (GBF) by providing financial and technical support to GEF-eligible Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD) in their work to align their National Biodiversity Strategies and Action Plans (NBSAP), including national biodiversity targets, monitoring, policy, and finance frameworks with the GBF.

NBSAP Forum



- Supports Parties in finding the information they need to develop and implement effective National Biodiversity Strategies and Action Plans (NBSAPs) and prepare national reports
- Hosted by the SCBD, UNDP, UNEP, and UNEP-WCMC in partnership, with funding from the GEF
- Brings together biodiversity practitioners and organizations from around the world who are involved in updating NBSAPs, and/or who can offer support and expertise to those preparing their NBSAP

Offerings on NBSAP Forum

- An online forum that connects practitioners and technical experts on the GBF targets
- A e-learning platform that provides free opportunities to build stakeholder's professional capacity in multiple languages
- A resource library with timely information regarding best practices, technical guidance, tools, and reports on GBF targets and connected themes
- A technical help desk providing service in English, French, and Spanish staffed by UNDP, UNEP, and SCBD






NBSAP Forum Technical Partnerships

- Consolidation of a resource database and focal points to support countries in the EAS project





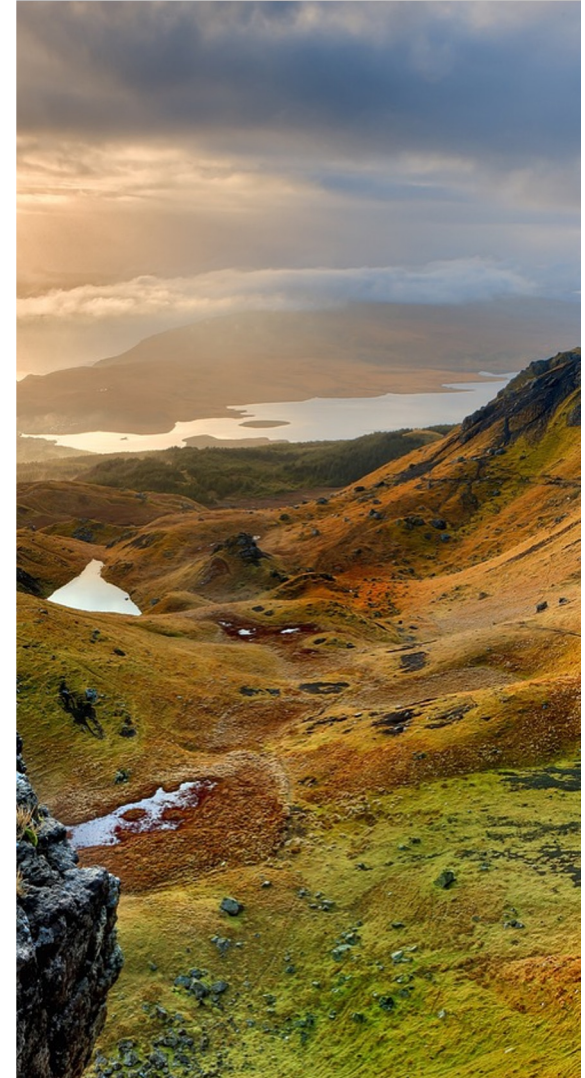
