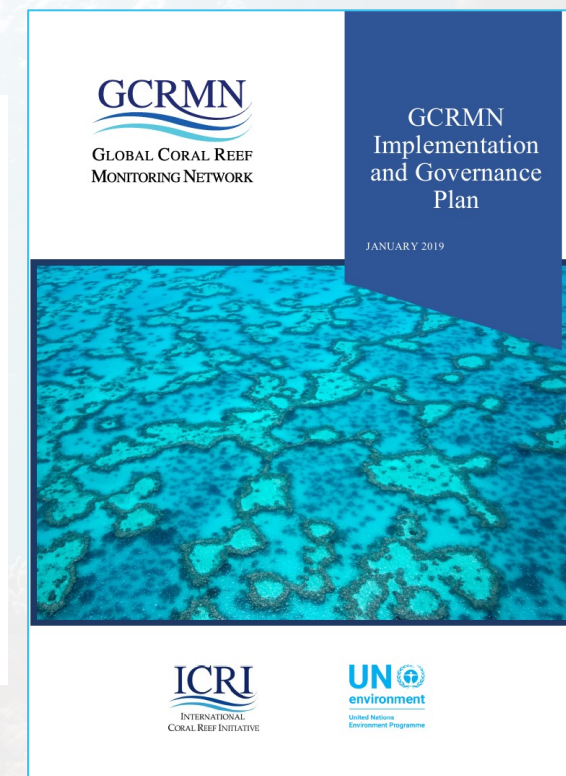

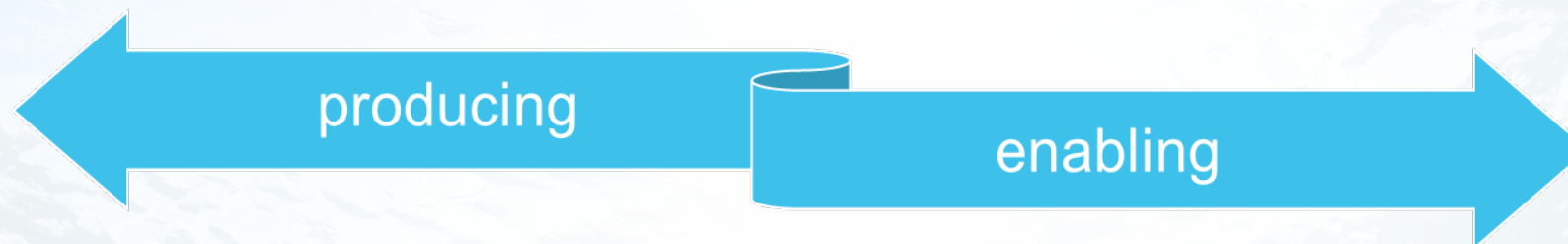

GOALS OF THE GCRMN

GOAL 1	Improve understanding of coral reef status and trends, globally and regionally
GOAL 2	Analyse and communicate coral reef biophysical, social and economic trends, providing science-based recommendations in support of raising awareness, management and policy development
GOAL 3	Enable and facilitate greater utilization of coral reef data, including in research
GOAL 4	Build human and technical capacity to collect, analyse and report biophysical and socio-economic data on coral reefs

- Define GCRMN's role in:
 - Knowledge exchange, coordination and capacity building, especially in data science
 - Creation of products that will support science-based coral reef conservation and management
 - Production or promotion of best-practice methods/manuals/protocols

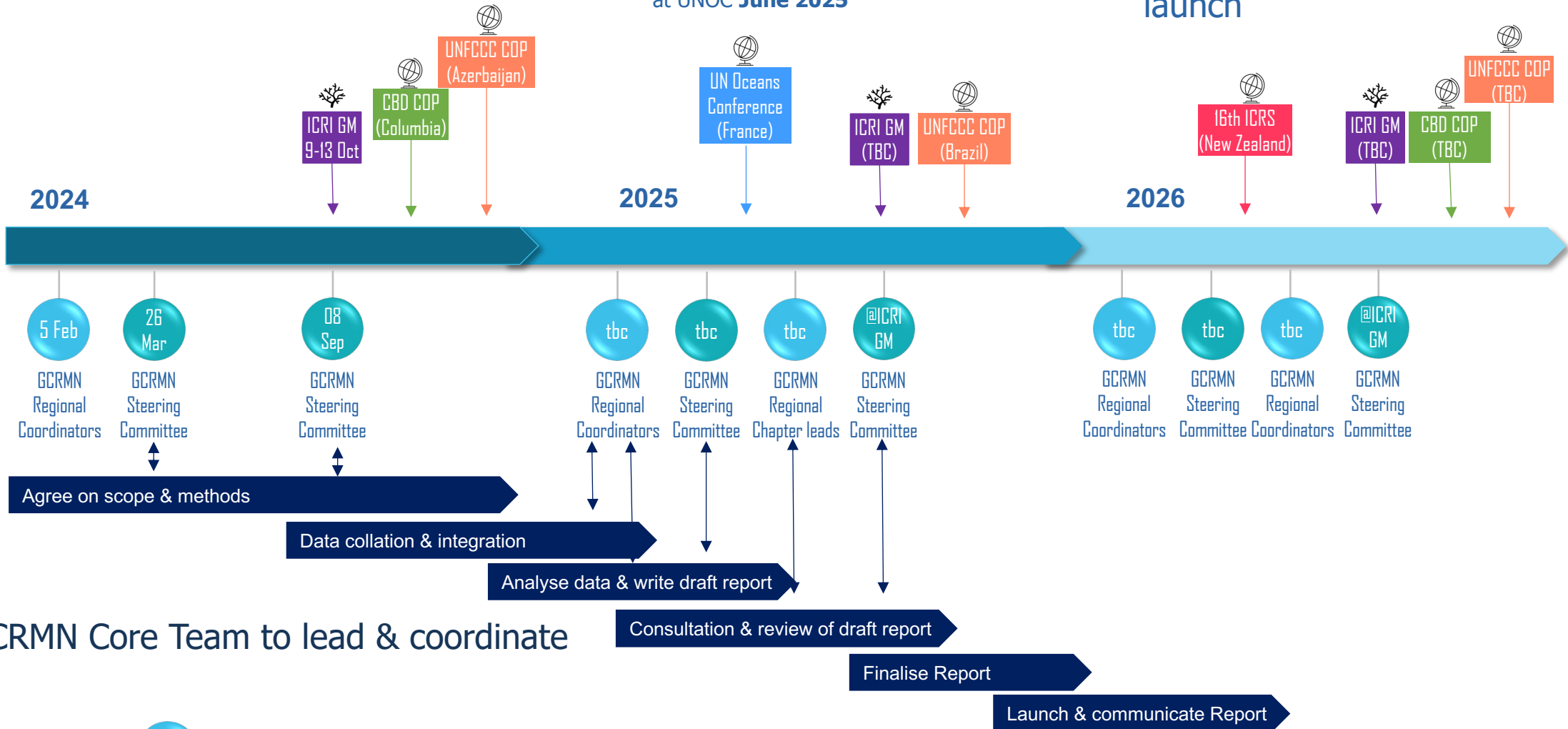

3. Create template for regional chapter in 2025 global report and send to SC and regional leads for last round of consultation.
4. Set up templates on google drive, ideally compatible with MS Word to allow use of standard in-text reference software.
5. Invite proposals for case studies from the 10 regions.
6. Invite contributions to mark the 30th anniversary of the GCRMN
