# INTERNATIONAL TROPICAL MARINE ECOSYSTEM MANAGEMENT SYMPOSIUM (ITMEMS)

- Flagship Activity of the International Coral Reef Initiative
- Typically held every four years
- Promotes the conservation and sustainable use of coral reefs and associated ecosystems including seagrasses and mangroves
- Targeted towards marine and coastal managers
- Aims to strengthen their knowledge and capacity through:
  - Encouraging knowledge exchange and cooperation
  - Demonstrating relevant application of technology and science
  - Providing targeted training and skills development
  - Developing networks for professional development and onward learning







# **ITMEMS-6** Format

- Held over 5 days
- Aiming for 150 attendees marine park managers
- Combination of practical activities and targeted training
- ~6 themes each with a dedicated training team and space
- ITMEMS attendees will choose 5 trainings and rotate between them each day
- Support for lasting professional networks





# **ITMEMS-6 Steering Committee**

- Made up of ICRI Secretariat, SHAMS staff, ICRI members, other invited parties
- TOR will include:
  - Selecting themes
  - Review concepts for sessions
  - Developing and reviewing the program
  - Identifying and contacting trainers
  - Assisting with promotion and fundraising
- Monthly meetings




